
That's somewhat ironic in that I have encouraged always others to ask for help when needed, always been willing to help others in need, and always said that there is no shame in asking for help.



She decides to give it another try, looks to the heavens, and says "just this once, please, I am asking for help." Well, it works...she is able to lift the horse's leg...and says "thank you"! Was that really so difficult?

It is good to know what you know, to have confidence in your abilities. But it is also






