camps, who said that "our greatest freedom is the freedom to choose our attitude". He had spent years under the most deplorable conditions with suffering and death all around him, but kept a sense of purpose and a positive attitude nonetheless. The fact is that he CHOSE to keep a good attitude under the worst possible conditions. He retained his dignity by choice. And so it is with us. We can choose misery or we can choose peace - which will it be for you?

I personally find it quite embarrassing that my former angry attitudes of victimhood and entitlement were a choice, not a terrible affliction thrust upon me by the cruel hands of fate. The vicious cycle of alcoholism kept me on a spiral decline of chaos, drama, and pessimism for many years. It was no surprise that upon entering recovery I was in a spiritual void of hopelessness and desperation. Bill Wilson warned us in the Big Book that "a body badly burned by alcohol does not often recover overnight nor do twisted thinking and depression vanish in a twinkling."

So what is it in our program that allows us to change our grievously grim outlook? The steps are the key to releasing the power of choice, the ability to change our outlook on life. In step one I have totally surrendered, beaten down to a state of (partial) willingness. In step two I can see that my thinking is insanely warped and that the folks in recovery generally have a better perspective. Perhaps I would benefit from their experience. In step three I make a decision to submit my will and my life back to my Creator (they are His anyway).

It was Viktor Frankl, a survivor of Nazi concentration At this point I felt like I had nothing left to lose! Steps 4 and 5 allow me to explore exactly who I am (and am not). My old ideas and bad (useless) attitudes come to light so that I can choose new healthy thinking and actions in steps 6 and 7. God can remold my psyche as I become willing to change. My opinionated negative perspectives can be replaced by helpful, compassionate, grateful, and humble attitudes.

> In steps 8 and 9 the errors of my past are made right and I can face the world as an equal instead of a moral leper. In step ten I have an opportunity to adjust my attitude with a "spot-check" inventory and a daily inventory, knowing (by now) that the way I see the world around me is really a simple choice. In step eleven I attempt to get even closer to my Creator, to bask in the "sunlight of the Spirit". Step twelve ensures that I keep connected with my brothers and sisters in recovery, that I may be of service. Also, and perhaps just as important, working with others allows me to see my own faults, quirks, and negativity as mirrored in another person.

> What a relief that our attitude, and therefore our peace and happiness comes down to our personal choice. If my perspective gets sour or grumpy at any point in my day, then I have the power to change it. I have the awareness, the acceptance, and finally the ability to take action to change my thinking. I am NOT a victim nor do I need to blame someone or something else for how I feel. I am forever grateful that the grace of God makes it possible that I can have the dignity of personal responsibility. -Anonymous



# Tradition 1

The Steps are HOW IT WORKS.
The Traditions are <u>WHY IT WORKS</u>.

"Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity."

Newcomers to a 12-step group will often place their entire focus on the Twelve Steps and pay less mind to the Twelve Traditions. In some ways, it's entirely understandable. As an individual, you want to reach your goal of sobriety. But unless you embrace the Twelve Traditions, your journey can become rudderless as you place "self" over others.

In the end, the Twelve Traditions provide the foundation by which individuals can navigate the Twelve Steps. Both are meant to provide you with the framework by which to live your life, not just stop drinking.

The underlying concept of Tradition 1 is that being of service to other people can help promote sobriety. One way to incorporate this concept into your own life is to work on doing things for others, even as you accept help toward your recovery.

Some ways to foster this sense of unity include participating in your 12-step group, sharing your experiences, and encouraging others in their progress.

You can also implement these practices within your own family unit. Instead of placing your own needs at the forefront, make sure each family member is seen and heard. Work on reaching consensus within the family unit. Each person may not get exactly what they want, but working together ensures that each person's needs are respected. -Buddy T



# Yes and no are two of the most important words that one will ever say.






# Faithful Fiver
